	egresses are swept clean of dirt, debris and asphalt.
	3. Ensure that all string lines are removed after use.
	4. Ensure that tools are not left on the ground.
	5. Ensure that work site in kept clean, organized and orderly.
	6. Ensure that equipment used in the process of cleaning up is in good
	working order and that you understand the method of operation prior
	to using equipment.
	7. Ensure that materials on site and in the yard are stacked and stored
	in the safest manner possible.
